**Minutes of May 23, 2019 Meeting:** The minutes were approved prior to posting in the back of church and on the website.

**Religion Classes:** The location for religion classes beginning next year will be discussed when there is more information available. This change is due to the elementary moving to Adams.

**Trees:** The removal of the large tree in the parking lot will be pursued.
